The AIS Vertical Team met on January 7, 2005 in a continued analysis of the K-12 AIS program. As a result of the team's research into the program, the following was determined:

 - There needs to be a summary of services to accompany the student records during these transitions.
- The team would benefit from a demonstration of an AIS program.

- Scheduling is an issue:
 - there is an excessive number of students needing services
 - students often do not receive services due to chorus or band
 - students lack time on task
- High School students receive services if they fail either the course, or the Regents exam
- Marvin will look into ordering empowerment materials for the AIS providers.
