CREDITS: 1

PREREQUISITES: Successful completion of Spanish I.

COURSE DESCRIPTION & OBJECTIVES:

This course continues the aural-oral approach, concentrating on finer points of grammar. A book a week is assigned for outside reading. The object of the course is to enable the student to understand, read and speak the Spanish language well enough so as to be understood by a native speaker with no knowledge of English.

INSTRUCTIONAL PROCESSES & MATERIALS:

1. Teacher-student conversation
2. Oral resumes of stories read
3. Oral comprehension exercises
4. Practice in reading (a book a week is assigned)
5. Composition – two compositions a week are due (one on book read during the week and one on weekly grammar test)
6. Hispanic Civilization – slides, videos and filmstrips

COURSE REQUIREMENTS & EVALUATION CRITERIA:

The following are in order of importance:

- Grammar and vocabulary tests
- Weekly composition on book assigned
- Homework
- Oral Work
