







TOTAL COHORT RESULTS IN SECONDARY-LEVEL MATHEMATICS AFTER FOUR YEARS OF INSTRUCTION











OVERALL GRADUATION RATE FOR ACCOUNTABILITY






FOUR-YEAR GRADUATION-RATE TOTAL COHORT FOR ACCOUNTABILITY






