

## How do I locate a book on the list?

Books on the recommended reading list are available through the Mid-Hudson Library System.

With your library card, you can request titles online using the Library System Catalog. Just follow these steps:

- Go to [www.midhudson.org](http://www.midhudson.org)
- Click on “Public Library Catalog”
- Search for a title, author, or subject.
- Click “Request”
- Follow the directions to request a book.
- Your pickup location will contact you when the book arrives.

If you have questions, your local library staff can help you.

If you do not have a library card, visit your local library. Bring proof of address and a parent. You will be issued one on the spot!
