MedicareRx Rewards (PDP)

How does it compare to your current plan?

- Offering UniCare's largest formulary
- The offering is based on a Medicare Part D Plan
- Covered Select Generics at a \$0 copayment
- Includes Extra Covered Drugs such as lifestyle plan drugs
- Removal of the \$50 deductible on the HealthyAdvantage Plan
- Removal of the ancillary charge for multi-source brands on the Alternate PPO Plan
- Mail order is NOT mandatory



Medicare Part D enhances your benefits by:



Helping pay for many brand-name and generic prescribed drugs.



Giving you a way to better predict and control your costs at the pharmacy.



Providing access to a drug list (formulary) to help you determine how your drugs will be covered.



Offering you options for filling your prescriptions at retail pharmacies or through the mail.

What you pay for your prescription depends on which drug you choose – generic or preferred drugs can save you money.



Prescription drug coverage

Initial and gap coverage phases – what to expect



Initial coverage phase

- You pay your copay or coinsurance, and your plan pays the rest of the cost of your covered drugs until the total cost of your covered Part D drugs reaches **\$3,900**.



Coverage gap phase

- You continue to pay your copay/coinsurance for both **Generic** and **Brand** drugs, after your Medicare RX Rewards have paid benefits.

Step 1

Select your order form from your post-enrollment materials. You also may contact Customer Service to receive an order form.

Step 2

Complete the form, including your prescription information.

3

Step 3

Return the form and prescriptions to the address listed on the form.

Step 4

Once you register, you may order medications online at **unicare.com** or by calling the Customer Service toll-free number.

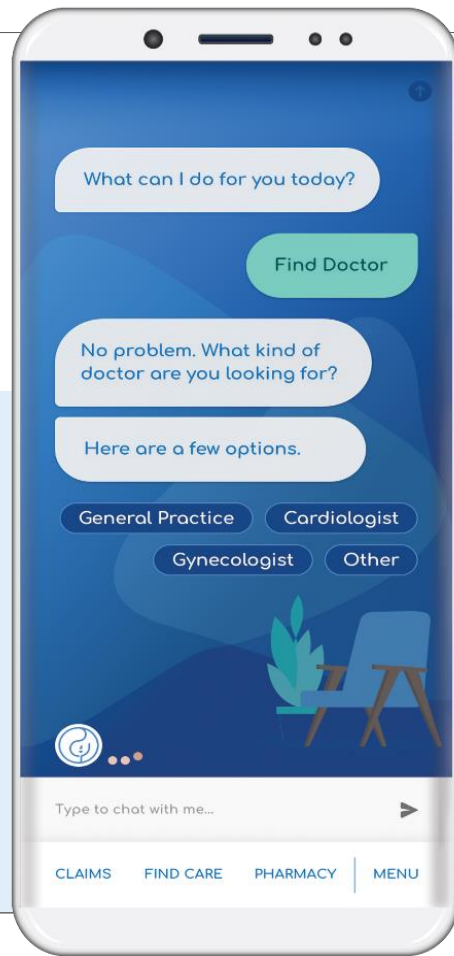

The mandatory mail order Rx benefit on all DEHIC plans requires members to obtain maintenance medications through mail order. This benefit allows for two new 30-day maintenance fills at a retail pharmacy and future fills must be obtained through mail order as 90 day prescriptions. The pharmacies noted above are participating within the mail order network, and therefore may be used by members to obtain 90 day prescriptions as an alternative to IngenioRx mail order.

Extra prescription drug help for those who need it

The Medicare Extra Help program helps people with limited resources pay for their prescription drugs.

Eligibility

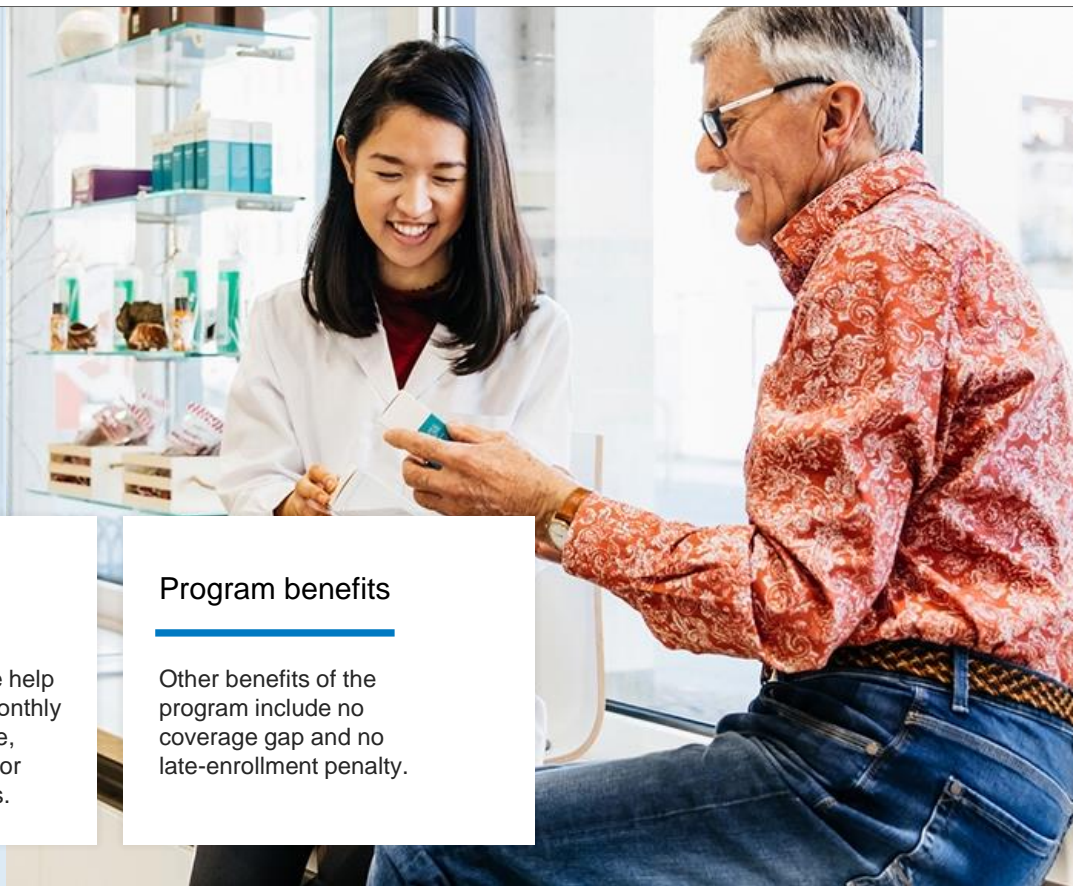
If you qualify and are enrolled in a Part D plan, Medicare can pay up to 100% of your prescribed drug costs.

Costs

Costs covered can include help toward your drug plan's monthly premium, yearly deductible, coinsurance, and copays for covered prescription drugs.

Program benefits

Other benefits of the program include no coverage gap and no late-enrollment penalty.



Understanding Part D – IRMAA

An income-related monthly adjusted amount (IRMAA) is a surcharge added to monthly Medicare Part B and Part D premiums, based on yearly income. The Social Security Administration will notify you if you are affected by Part D IRMAA.

Income limit for beneficiary filing an individual income tax return or filing separately from spouse:

>\$91,000

Income limit for a beneficiary filing a joint tax return:

>\$182,000

Two ways to pay the IRMAA:

1

Deduct the amount from Social Security

2

Pay Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) directly
