## POLICY COMMITTEE MINUTES DECEMBER 8, 2016

The Committee had further discussions regarding Policy #5280, Interscholastic Athletic, on the subject of "coachability", and whether there should be wording that makes the idea clearer, or to explain what "coachability" means.

Joe will discuss with Steve Boucher what the expectations are of coaches who will be making decisions about cuts, including the idea of "coachability."

The Committee reviewed the following policies:

5305 - Eligibility for Extracurricular Activities

Last sentence of #3, "Students absent for more than four of the day's nine periods on a Friday or a day before a holiday will not be eligible to participate in any extracurricular activity on Saturday, Sunday or a school holiday unless the absence falls under one of the exceptions described above.", to be removed as it seems to prohibit participation over a long school break.

5311.3 – Student Complaints and Grievances No changes

5311.4 – Care of School Property by Students Last sentence (regarding regulations) to be removed.

5410 – Wellness Current policy is under review by the Wellness Committee.

5415 – Concussions and Concussion Management No changes

5420 – Student Health Services
Policy to be reviewed by school nurses and school physician.

5425 – Hypodermic Needles and Syringes No changes

5430 – Student Psychological Services No changes

5431 - Suicide Prevention

Referred to Emily Davison for review.

5450 – Student Safety No changes

5450.1 – Sex-offender Registration Notification No changes

At our next meeting in January, we will review technology related policies. Steve Jensen is currently working with legal counsel on these.
