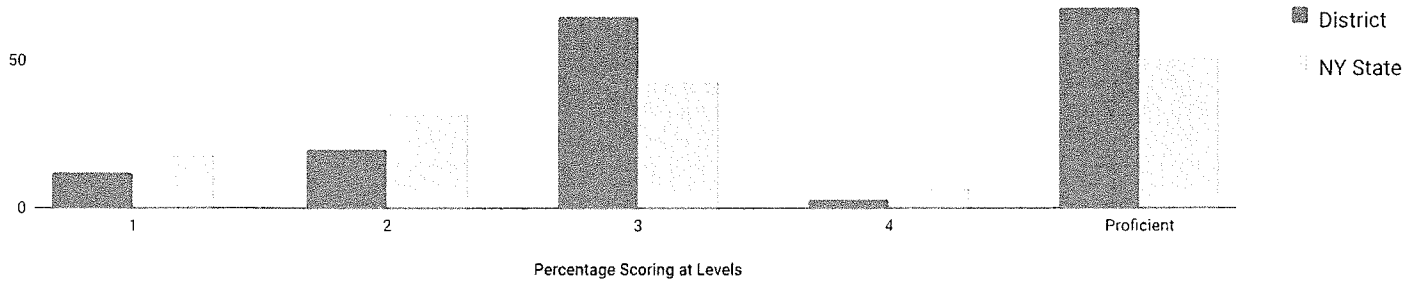

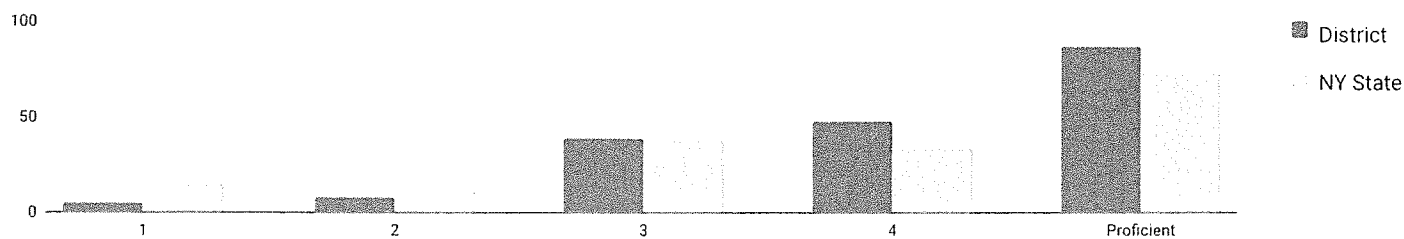
# ANNUAL REGENTS LIVING ENVIRONMENT (2017-18)

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## DRAFT BOE GOALS FOR 2019-2020

- Complete and present to the Board of Education by April 1, 2020 a three-five year Long Range Plan that will address academic opportunities for children within the context of financial considerations and declining enrollment.
- Continue to assess the effectiveness of social and emotional wellness intervention programs and strategies to create and provide activities for improved self-esteem, responsible behavior, and academic development through in-school and extracurricular activities.
- Expand the implementation of a Learning Management System for the improvement of curricular alignment, teacher-parent communication, and teacher-student interaction, in support of the objectives articulated in the CDEP report. This will be a multi-year endeavor involving all three buildings to incrementally deploy the Learning Management System across all grade levels.
