The committee discussed the new draft of policy 9410 Instructional Substitute compensation. This policy will go to the full board for a first reading.

The group also discussed a possible policy regarding voter registration for students. This would be a new policy based on education law that would give students access to preregister if they are at least 16 but will not be 18 by the next election. Joe will gather more information about this law. The schools current practice is to offer this as part of the senior government class. The committee felt that it is important not just to offer registration but to educated students on what it means and what choices they have available to them.

Joe will check to make sure we do not have to update any of our current policies to reflect the change in law regarding immunization exemptions.
